

2020 Important Election Dates

Candidate Filing

December 30, 2019 Applications received by mail must be post- marked no later than 12/30/19 and online applications must be submitted before 11:59 p.m. 12/30/19.	Last Day for Candidates for Partisan Offices to Change Affiliation with a Major Party: No person may be a candidate of a <u>major political party</u> for partisan office in 2020 if he or she changed political affiliation to Democrat or Republican on a Voter Registration Application in Nevada or in any other state after December 30, 2019. (NRS 293.176)
January 2, 2020 Thursday	First Day Independent Candidate may Submit Petition for Approval: Independent candidates must submit their petition of candidacy to the appropriate filing officer for approval prior to circulating the petition. (NRS 293.200(1)(a))
January 6-17, 2020 Weekdays, 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.	Judicial Candidate Filing: Period during which judicial candidates for District Court, and Justice of the Peace, as applicable, may file to run for office in 2020. (NRS 293.177(1)(a))
January 17, 2020 Friday, 5:00 p.m.	Last Day for Judicial Candidate Name Changes: Last day judicial candidates may change how their name appears on the ballot. (NAC 293.081)
January 28, 2020 Wednesday, 5:00 p.m.	Last Day to Withdraw or Rescind Withdrawal of Judicial Candidacy: Last day judicial candidates may withdraw their candidacy or rescind withdrawal of candidacy. (NRS 293.202)
March 2-13, 2020 Weekdays, 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.	Candidate Filing: Period during which non-judicial candidates may file to run for office in 2020. (NRS 293.177(1)(b))
March 13, 2020 Friday, 5:00 p.m.	Last Day for Candidate Name Changes (Non-Judicial): Last day non- judicial candidates may change how their name appears on the ballot. (NAC 293.081)
March 24, 2020 Tuesday, 5:00 p.m.	Last Day to Withdraw or Rescind Withdrawal of Candidacy (Non- Judicial): Last day non-judicial candidates may withdraw their candidacy or rescind withdrawal of candidacy. (NRS 293.202)

May 12, 2020 Tuesday	Close of Standard Registration: Last day to register to vote, without having to register on the Secretary of State's website. (as amended by AB345 of the 2019 legislative session)
No later than May 20, 2020	Sample Ballots Mailed to all Active Registered Voters (NRS 293.565(6))
May 23-June 5, 2020 Saturday-Friday, excluding Sunday	Early Voting (14 Days): Historic Courthouse will serve as main early voting center, several branch locations will be scheduled as well. Visit govotedouglas.com or view your sample ballot for more details. (NRS 293.3568) Same Day Registration will be available. (As approved in AB345 of the 2019 legislative session).

May 26, 2020 Tuesday, 5:00 p.m.	Mail-in (Absentee) Ballot Request Deadline: Last day for the Douglas County Clerk's office to RECEIVE absentee ballot requests. <i>(as amended by AB345 of the 2019 legislative session)</i>
Through June 4, 2020 Thursday	Extended Online Registration: You may register to vote ONLY on the Secretary of State's website. Registrants must have Nevada DL/ID. <i>(as amended by AB345 of the 2019 legislative session)</i>
June 9, 2020 Tuesday, 7:00 a.m.- 7:00 p.m.	Primary Election- Same Day Registration will be available. <i>(as approved in AB345 of the 2019 legislative session)</i>
