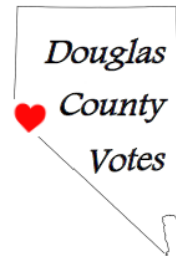

## Douglas County Primary Election 2020 Wrap Up

### Overview of Local Election Offices

#### **Douglas County Commissioner, District 1**

**Danny Tarkanian** received the highest votes and his name will appear on the General Election ballot, unopposed.

#### **Douglas County Commissioner, District 3**

**Mark Gardner** received the highest number of votes and his name will appear on the General Election ballot, along with Libertarian candidate **Charles Holt**.

#### **Douglas County Commissioner, District 5**

**Walter "Walt" Nowosad** received the highest number of votes and his name will appear on the General Election ballot, unopposed.

#### **Douglas County School Board Trustee, Area 4**

**Carey Kangas** received the highest votes and is elected. His name will not appear on the General Election Ballot.

#### **Douglas County School Board Trustee, Area 5**

**Linda Gilkerson** received the highest votes and is elected. Her name will not appear on the General Election Ballot.

### **Indian Hills General Improvement District**

There are two offices up for election at the General Election, therefore the four highest vote getters will move forward to the General Election ballot.
